

PRIVACY POLICY

NOTICE

The Association of International Graduate Admissions Consultants respects the privacy of its members and other visitors to its Web site. To protect online privacy, AIGAC has implemented the following policy.

ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS

By using this site you signify your consent to this Privacy Policy. If you do not agree with our Privacy Policy, please refrain from using this site.

INFORMATION COLLECTED

Certain information is automatically collected regarding use and/or actions on the AIGAC web site, such as user traffic patterns, page views, click-through rates, and search terms. In addition, when a visitor arrives at our site, we collect the IP address, operating system, and browser software used. Personally identifiable information also is collected by a variety of means, for example, through the membership registration form, e-mail newsletter registration and/or event registration forms. This information includes, but is not limited to, your name (first and last), company name, company address, phone number, fax number, and e-mail address.

USE OF INFORMATION
